
Partnership Resources

DAY OF EVENT



The Care Hub was a one-day event that aimed to provide a comprehensive range of services to individuals and families experiencing homelessness and hardships. It was held on January 17th, 2023 at 800 Barretto Street Bronx NY 10474 and began at 12:00 pm and ended at 4:00 pm. The event was open to the public and was advertised through local community organizations, churches, and shelters. The Care Hub was staffed by our team of dedicated volunteers who were committed to providing a compassionate and caring environment for all participants. Upon arrival, participants were greeted by a team of volunteers who provided them with a welcoming and informative orientation. They were then directed to the different areas of the event where they could access the services and resources available.




The Care Hub was divided into different stations, each focused on a specific need. The stations included food and clothing distribution, health-care screenings, spiritual and mental health support, and information and referral services. Each station was staffed by trained professionals who were available to assist participants and provide them with the support and resources they needed.

Food + Clothing 🍅

One of the main focus of The Care Hub was providing food and clothing to those in need. Food insecurity and lack of appropriate clothing are two of the most pressing issues faced by individuals and families experiencing homelessness and hardship. Immanuel Cares Global recognized this and made providing food and clothing a priority for The Care Hub.

The food and clothing provided not only met the basic needs of participants but also helped to improve their overall well-being and quality of life. The generous contributions of local churches and community members made it possible to provide these essential resources to those in need.







Health Care Screenings



The Care Hub provided health-care screenings for participants, with medical professionals on hand. They provided basic health screenings and information about available resources for further medical care. Such screenings were conducted in a private and secure area, and participants were able to discuss any concerns or issues they had with the medical professionals. The screenings included checking, vital signs, blood pressure, temperature, STI testing, and free vaccination was provided for all ages.

The health-care screenings provided at The Care Hub were crucial in ensuring that participants had access to the basic health care screenings they needed. Participants were able to receive medical attention for any underlying health issues, and the medical professionals were able to provide them with information about available resources for further medical care.

Spiritual and Mental Health Support (



The Care Hub recognized that addressing the spiritual and mental health needs of individuals and families experiencing homelessness and hardship is just as important as addressing their physical needs. Immanuel Cares Global, the organization behind The Care Hub, understands that these individuals and families may be dealing with a range of emotional and psychological issues, such as stress, anxiety, and depression, as a result of their difficult circumstances.

To address these needs, The Care Hub provided spiritual and mental health support for participants. Pastoral care and counseling services were available throughout the event, providing a safe space for individuals to discuss their struggles and receive support. The pastoral care and counseling services were provided by trained professionals who were able to provide emotional and spiritual support to participants. The sessions were designed to provide a safe and confidential space for participants to talk about their struggles and receive emotional support. The pastoral care and counseling services were also designed to provide participants with the tools and resources they needed to cope with their difficult circumstances, and to improve their overall emotional and spiritual well-being.

The counseling services provided at the event were also designed to address the mental health needs of participants. Trained counselors were available to provide individual and group counseling services, as well as provide information about available resources for ongoing support. They were able to provide support for a variety of mental health issues such as stress, anxiety, and depression, and provide guidance and support for coping with difficult situations.

Care Packages Distribution

Immanuel Cares Global partnered with Bless It Bag® a public charity whose mission is to give people a simple way to help improve the homeless population's quality of life. We handed out "Bless it Bag" care packages to those who visited the event resources as cherry on the top for stopping by The Care Hub. These care packages for (men and women) included: 4 non-perishable food items, a change of underwear, a change of socks, roll-on deodorant, 2 hand-sanitizer wipes, a pack of flushable wipes, a tissue pack, chapstick, body lotion, tooth brush, toothpaste, comb, a full wash cloth, sunscreen packet, a bar of soap and other items which are everyday basic necessities.


